



OMNI takes the welfare and safety of our patients and staff extremely seriously. In response to the COVID19 pandemic, OMNI has compiled the following guidance for the performance of ultrasound in gynaecological indications and pregnancy. We continue to provide essential imaging for women in a safe environment across all 3 OMNI sites.

1. Preparation and cleaning of ultrasound equipment and transducer

Our ultrasound rooms, ultrasound machines and ultrasound probes are cleaned in accordance with the International Society of Obstetrics and Gynecology (ISUOG) Safety Committee Position Statement.

2. Protecting the patient and ultrasound providers

We screen all patients and visitors using standardised checklists for symptoms of acute respiratory infection as well as risk factors based on travel history, occupation, contact and cluster (TOCC).

We limit the number of visitors in the ultrasound room to a maximum of one and do not allow the presence of children.

All sonographers and sonologists wear surgical face masks when performing ultrasound scans.

All sonographers and sonologists adhere to strict hand hygiene procedures. Our team carry out obligatory hand washing before and after direct patient contact with liquid soap and hand sanitisers.

We have sourced infrared thermometers and will implement temperature screening for ALL staff and patients upon arrival.
